**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MISSISSIPPI COUNTY QUORUM COURT
ORDINANCE NO. 0-2003-8, AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF AN
ADDITIONAL TWENTY DOLLAR (\$20.00) FINE TO HELP DEFRAY THE
EXPENSE OF INCARCERATION OF PRISONERS, PURSUANT TO ACT
209 OF 2009 (AMENDING ACT 1188 OF 2003), AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas has passed Act 209 of 2009 (Amending Act 1188 of 2003 and Arkansas Code Annotated, Section 16-17-129) to authorize county governments to levy an additional fine of up to Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) to help defray the expense of incarcerating prisoners in the county jail; and

WHEREAS, said Act authorizes the Quorum Court of Mississippi County, Arkansas, to levy and collect an additional fine, not to exceed Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) in addition to all fines now or as may hereafter be provided by law, from each defendant who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, is found guilty of, or forfeits bond for any misdemeanor or traffic violation in the District Courts within Mississippi County, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, since Mississippi County operates a county regional detention facility, the additional fine levied by the County under said Act shall be deposited into a special fund within the County Treasury to be used exclusively for maintenance, operation, and capital expenditures of the Regional Detention Facility; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly for the State of Arkansas has indicated that the intent of said Act provides that revenues derived from the additional fines levied under said Act shall not offset or reduce funding from other sources for the maintenance, operation, and capital expenditures of the detention facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests and welfare of the citizens of Mississippi County, Arkansas, that an additional fine of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) be levied and collected from each defendant who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, is found guilty of, or forfeits bond for any misdemeanor or traffic violation in the District Court for the Blytheville or Chickasawba District of Mississippi County, Arkansas, and the District

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Court for the Osceola District of Mississippi County, Arkansas, within Mississippi County, Arkansas, pursuant to the referenced Acts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MISSISSIPPI COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

I.

Pursuant to Act 209 of 2009 (Amending Act 1188 of 2003) of the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas, an additional fine of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) shall be levied and collected from each defendant who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, is found guilty of, or forfeits bond for any misdemeanor or traffic violation in the District Court for the Chickasawba (Blytheville) District of Mississippi County, and the District Court for the Osceola District of Mississippi County, within Mississippi County, Arkansas.

II.

The additional fine levied by the County under this Ordinance shall be deposited into a special fund within the County Treasury, and the revenues generated by the additional fine shall be used exclusively for maintenance, operation, and capital expenditures of the Mississippi County Detention Center.

III.

Revenues derived from the additional fines levied under this Ordinance shall not offset or reduce funding from other sources for the maintenance, operation, and capital expenditures of the Mississippi County Detention Center.

IV.
EMERGENCY CLAUSE:

It is found and determined by the Quorum Court of Mississippi County, Arkansas, that the increasing costs of incarcerating, or otherwise keeping prisoners in County Jails creates an economic hardship, and that this Ordinance is immediately necessary because of said economic hardship. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance, being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall become effective on July 1, 2009, simultaneous with the effective date of Act 209 of 2009.





**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SHORT-TERM FINANCING FOR
THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT UNDER
THE PROVISIONS OF AMENDMENT 78 OF THE ARKANSAS
CONSTITUTION.**

WHEREAS, Amendment 78 of the Arkansas Constitution authorizes counties to obtain short-term financing, not to exceed five years, at fixed or variable interest not to exceed the maximum lawful rate, for the acquisition of property with a useful life of greater than one year; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to construct a maintenance building and purchase one bull dozier and one backhoe for the Mississippi County Landfill; and said expenditures have been approved and recommended by the Landfill and Solid Waste Committee and the Finance Committee of the Mississippi County Quorum Court; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the County to obtain financing for such expenditures.

***NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF
MISSISSIPPI COUNTY, ARKANSAS:***

That the Mississippi County Judge is hereby authorized to borrow up to \$250,000.00 from a financial entity for the construction of a maintenance building, the purchase of a bull dozier, and the purchase of a backhoe for the Mississippi County Landfill, upon interest rates and terms to be negotiated by the County Judge in compliance with the provisions of Amendment 78 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Act 1808 of 2001, with payment terms not to exceed five years and interest not to exceed the maximum lawful rate, and to secure said loan by a pledge of said property.




